The present contempt petition has been filed pleading that the interim order dated 02.07.2018 passed by this Court in CWP No. 15776 of 2018 has not been complied with. The operational part of the order is reproduced below:

“ Contends that vide order dated 19.02.2018, the petitioner was given extension of one year service beyond 58 years by his Excellency, the Governor of Punjab, but his services stand terminated by the subordinate authority i.e. Additional Chief Secretary, Punjab without issuing any show cause notice or charge-sheet to him.

Notice of motion for 05.10.2018.

Operation and effect of order dated 27.06.2018 (Annexure P-9) shall remain stayed till the next date of hearing.”

Learned State counsel has filed reply in Court today. The same is taken on record. Copy be given to the opposite counsel.

Mr. Kumar Rahul, IAS, Secretary Home, Punjab appears in Court as Dr. N.S. Kalsi, IAS, Additional Chief Secretary, Punjab has retired yesterday.

The bone of controversy is that in spite of the order dated 02.07.2018 passed by this Court, staying the operation and effect of order dated 27.06.2018. A notice dated 25.07.2018 Annexure P-3 was issued by the Inspector General, Police, Punjab, Chandigarh to the petitioner for not handing over the charge.

Mr. Kumar Rahul, IAS, Secretary Home, Punjab, who is present in Court states that show cause notice dated 25.07.2018 (Annexure P-3) as well as consequent proceedings in pursuance thereto, will be withdrawn.

In view of the statement made in Court, the contempt petition has been rendered infructuous.

Disposed of accordingly.
