The petitioner seeks grant of anticipatory bail in case FIR No.763, dated 3.12.2018, registered under Sections 13 & 7 of the Prevention of Corruption Act, at Police Station City Rohtak.

Allegations against the petitioner were that he had falsely arrested the husband of the complainant in a case under the NDPS Act and was demanding bribe for helping him.

At the very outset, learned DAG Haryana, on instructions from DSP Gorakh Pal, has stated that there are recorded calls from the mobile number of the petitioner and as per those recordings, the petitioner is demanding money.

Counsel for the petitioner has stated that the petitioner would

have no objection in handing over his mobile phone and give his voice samples but till such time as the report of the FSL comes, he should be granted interim bail.

I find favour with the argument of counsel for the petitioner. In view of the facts and circumstances of the case as well as the statement made by counsel for the petitioner, let the petitioner appear before the Investigating Officer on 28.03.2019 or on any other day on which the Investigating Officer requires his presence, and in the event of his arrest, the petitioner shall be released on interim anticipatory bail by the Investigating Officer to his satisfaction. The petitioner would hand over his mobile phone (without deleting any material therein) and would also give his voice samples. After the receipt of the FSL report, final order would be passed by the concerned Court of Sessions in accordance with law.

This petition stands disposed of.

Since the main case has been decided, the pending C.Ms, if any, also stand disposed of.
