Petitioners who are three in number have approached this Court by way of filing of the instant writ petition seeking a mandamus for directing respondents No. 1 and 2 to ensure protection of their life and liberty as also their family members.

The prayer in the petition is founded on the premise that respondent No.3 namely Paramjeet Singh, SHO, Police Station Khalra, District Tarn Taran is harassing the petitioners for no rhyme and reason and has even gone to the extent of demolishing certain structures that had been built by the petitioners/their family members. To substantiate such assertion counsel would advert to the photographs placed on record at Annexure P-1.

Having heard counsel for the patentors at length, instant writ petition is disposed of in terms of granting liberty to the petitioners to approach the Senior Superintendent of Police, Tarn Taran as regards the

threat perception at the hands of respondent No.3. It would also be open for the petitioners to avail of any other alternate civil remedy against the back drop of the allegations of any structure that may have been demolished unlawfully.

Disposed of.
