Prayer in this petition is for grant of interim bail to the petitioner on account of marriage of his son namely Balwinder Singh, which is scheduled to be held on 16/17.03.2019, in FIR No.84 dated 23.09.2016 under Section 22 of NDPS Act, registered at Police Station Subhanpur, District Kapurthala.

Notice of motion.

On asking of the Court, Mr. Sidakmeet S. Sandhu, AAG, Punjab accepts notice on behalf of the respondent-State and he has obtained the information from the Superintendent, Central Jail, Kapurthala and as per the custody certificate supplied by the jail authorities, the petitioner remained on interim bail from 28.10.2016 till 05.06.2018 and is involved in one more FIR No.57 dated 26.05.2014 under Sections 21/22/61/85 of NDPS Act, Police Station Subhanpur, District Kapurthala.

Learned counsel for the petitioner has placed on record photocopy

of the order dated 26.11.2014, vide which the petitioner was granted default bail in aforesaid FIR No.57 dated 26.05.2014.

Considering the fact that marriage of son of the petitioner is scheduled to be held on 16/17.03.2019, this petition is allowed and the petitioner is directed to be released on interim bail till 28.03.2019, subject to furnishing his bail/surety bond to the satisfaction of the trial Court/Illaq Magistrate/Duty Magistrate.

The petitioner will surrender before the jail authorities on 28.03.2019 before 5.00 p.m.

Petition is disposed of.
