ANUPINDER SINGH GREWAL, J (ORAL)

The petitioner is seeking regular bail in FIR No. 125, dated 25.07.2015, under Sections 326, 324 and 34 of the Indian Penal Code ('IPC' - for short) registered at Police Station Kamboj, District Amritsar.

Learned counsel for the petitioner contends that the FIR is an outcome of sudden fight between the residents of the same locality and the matter has now been compromised. He has drawn attention of the Court to the copy of the compromise which is annexed as Annexure P-3. The petitioner is in custody for over 3 months. He further contends that the petitioner is 25 years of age and is not involved in any other case.

Learned State counsel, on instructions contends that upon completion of investigation in the case, the challan has been presented but no prosecution witness has been examined. She, however, contends that since it is an offence against the State, it cannot be compromised.

Heard.

However, at this stage, I have only to consider whether the petitioner would be entitled to the benefit of regular bail.

In view of the submissions of the learned counsel for the petitioner especially when the petitioner is not involved in any other case, he is in custody for over three months and conclusion of the trial is likely to take some time, I deem it a fit case to grant the concession of regular bail to the petitioner.

Therefore, without expressing any opinion on the merits of the case, the instant petition is allowed. The petitioner is ordered to be released on regular bail on his furnishing requisite bonds to the satisfaction of the trial Court/Duty Magistrate concerned.
