Even reply to the legal notice has not been submitted.

Learned counsel for the petitioners submits that the petitioners would be satisfied, in case, the directions are issued to respondent No.3 for taking action on the pending legal notice.

Keeping in view the limited prayer, the present petition is disposed of with a direction to respondent No.3 to consider the legal notice dated 25.07.2018 (Annexure P-13) and take necessary action thereupon in accordance with law within a period of four weeks from the date of receipt of certified copy of the order.
