MAHABIR SINGH SINDHU, J. (Oral)

Present petition has been filed under Section 482 Cr.P.C. for directing the respondent Nos.1 and 2 to protect the life and liberty of the petitioners at the hands of respondent No.3.

In pursuance of the notice of motion, issued by this Court, reply by way of affidavit dated 30.07.2018 of Sh. Yadwinder Singh, DSP (City), Ferozepur on behalf of the respondents has been filed in the Registry of this Court. The same is taken on record.

Perusal of preliminary submission No.1 of the affidavit reveals that as a matter of fact, on 09.11.2017, an FIR No.329, under Section 15 of the NDPS Act, Police Station Sadar, Ferozepur was registered against accused Sukhdev Singh, Hira Singh, Baljit Singh and Gurdev Singh on the basis of secret information. The affidavit further reveals that petitioners

have never been harassed by respondent No.3; nor their presence is required regarding the FIR mentioned above and thus, the allegations are total unfounded. Paragraph 5 further reveals that no criminal case is pending against the petitioners, therefore, there is no question of any threat at the hands of respondent No.3.

In view of above, no further directions are required to be issued in the present case.

Accordingly, the present petition is disposed off.

However, it is clarified that in case the occasion so arises, petitioners would be at liberty to approach this Court again.
