The petitioner was initially posted at Sonipat. Vide order dated 20.09.2017 (Annexure P-1), he was transferred from Sonipat to Yamuna Nagar. This transfer order was cancelled vide order dated 25.09.2017 (Annexure P-3) on the ground that petitioner was suffering from heart ailment and he could get treatment from Delhi. Subsequently vide order dated 17.11.2017 (Annexure P-4), he was transferred from Sonipat to Mewat. The petitioner joined on 23.11.2017 as even Mewat was closer to Delhi for his treatment. Now vide order dated 09.03.2019 (Annexure P-9), he has again been transferred before completing 02 years from Nuh to Sirsa by giving relaxation in transfer policy.

This writ petition is being allowed keeping in view transfer order dated 09.03.2019 (Annexure P-9) has been made one day before implementation of code of conduct and there was no need to give relaxation in transfer policy. Hence, order dated 09.03.2019 (Annexure P-9) qua the petitioner is quashed.
