The present contempt petition has been filed pleading wilful disobedience of the order dated 6.10.2018 passed by this Court in CWP No. 25713 of 2018. The operative part of the said order is reproduced below:

“Without expressing any opinion on the merits of the case, this petition is disposed of by giving direction to respondent No. 2 to decide the legal notice dated 25.7.2018 (Annexure P-3) in accordance with law expeditiously.”

Learned counsel for the State has produced copy of order dated 26.8.2019 whereby the claim of the petitioners has been rejected. Copy thereof has been given to learned counsel for the petitioners.

In view of the order passed, the contempt petition is disposed of as infructuous. However, the petitioners would be at liberty to avail remedies available in accordance with law against the order passed.
