By this order, CRM-M-23127 of 2017 and CRM-M-911 of
2017 shall stand disposed of.

After arguing at length, learned counsel for the petitioners

(in both petitions) prays for permission to withdraw the petitions with liberty to file an appropriate application before the Court where trial of the case is pending.

The grievance of the petitioners is that the prosecuting agency has not carried out proper investigation and the case requires further investigation. In the considered view of this Court, since the learned Judge before whom the trial is pending would have benefit of perusing the entire case file, therefore, it would be appropriate to file such application before the trial Court.

In view of the prayer made above, both the petitions are dismissed as withdrawn with the liberty aforesaid.

Needless to observe that if such an application is filed, the Court would pass an appropriate order expeditiously.

The pending miscellaneous application, if any in both the petitions, shall stand disposed of accordingly.
