The petitioners seek grant of anticipatory bail in Complaint No.109, dated 15.7.2014, filed under Sections 365, 323, 342, 295-A, 506, 148, 149 of the IPC, titled as Gajjan Singh vs Balwinder Kaur and others.

Even on second call, none has entered appearance on behalf of the complainant/respondent. On 31.05.2018, the following order was passed :-

“ Learned counsel for the petitioners has submitted that the petitioners have been summoned as accused in a complaint case. He has further submitted that petitioner No.1 is serving in the Indian Army.

Notice of motion for 14.08.2018.

Meanwhile, the petitioners are directed to surrender before the learned trial Court/Illaq Magistrate and on doing so, they shall be released on interim bail by

that Court to its satisfaction.”

In the circumstances, I do not deem it appropriate to deny the concession of anticipatory bail to the petitioners. Consequently, the order dated 31.5.2018 is made absolute. This petition stands disposed of.

Since the main case has been decided, the pending C.Ms, if any, also stand disposed of.
