Present petition under Section 439 Cr.P.C. for seeking regular bail to the petitioner in case FIR No. 168, dated 05.02.2018, registered under Sections 148, 149, 323, 427, 506, 302 IPC at Police Station City Ballabgarh, District Faridabad.

Learned counsel representing the petitioner contended that petitioner, who is 19 years of young boy, is in custody since 15.02.2018 and has been falsely implicated in this case though he was not named in the FIR.

Learned State counsel contended that original FIR was against 14-15 persons and during investigation, six accused persons had come up and the petitioner is one of them. More so, after framing of charge, almost all the material witnesses have been examined except two and now the next date is fixed for 01.07.2019 before the learned Magistrate.

Learned counsel for the petitioner further contended that he would be satisfied if trial of the case expedited and ordered to be decided within specific time frame.

In view of above, present petition is disposed of with a direction to the learned trial Judge to expedite the trial and try to conclude the same within a period of four months from today.
