AJAY TEWARI, J. (ORAL)

This petition has been filed under Section 439 Cr.P.C. for grant of regular bail to the petitioner in case FIR No.103 dated 10.07.2016 registered under Sections 302, 34 IPC and Section 201 IPC and Section 25 of the Arms Act (added later on) at Police Station Bahin, District Palwal.

As per the FIR, the informant had discovered a dead body of his son and had named two persons including one Saddam. On Saddam having been arrested, he disclosed that he, the deceased, the petitioner and 3 or 4 persons were actually working together to sell cows to slaughter house. The whole operation was being led by one Dilshad. On the fateful day, the deceased had an altercation with Dilshad who pulled out his country made pistol and shot him. Counsel for the petitioner has argued that if this story is accepted, on its own face value it is clear that the petitioner had no role in

evidence against the petitioner.

Learned Assistant Advocate General on instructions from ASI Ranbir Singh has accepted these factual assertions.

Custody certificate filed in Court dated 08.04.2019 by Ramesh Kumar - Deputy Superintendent, District Prison, Faridabad, Haryana is taken on record. As per the custody certificate, the petitioner has undergone 07 months of custody.

Keeping in view the entire conspectus of facts and the period of incarceration already suffered by the petitioner, without going into the merits of the case, I deem it appropriate to grant regular bail to the petitioner. Ordered accordingly. Bail to the satisfaction of the concerned Illaqa Magistrate/CJM/trial Court/Duty Magistrate.

Petition stands allowed.

Since the main case has been decided, the pending criminal miscellaneous application, if any, also stands disposed of.
