Petitioners have approached this Court under Articles 226/227 of the Constitution of India, seeking a writ in the nature of *Certiorari*, for setting aside the notices dated 30.06.2018, 08.09.2018 and 21.01.2019 (**Annexures P-1, P-2 & P-4**) respectively issued under Sections 13(2), 13(4) and 14 respectively of the Securitization and Reconstruction of Financial Assets and Enforcement of Securities Interest Act, 2002.

2. After arguing for sometime, learned counsel for the petitioners submitted that he may be allowed to withdraw the present writ petition with liberty to the petitioners either to approach the respondent-Bank or take recourse to the alternative remedies as may be available to them, in accordance with law.

3. Dismissed as withdrawn. It shall, however, be open to the petitioners to take recourse to the remedies as may be available to them, in accordance with law.
