After hearing learned counsel for the parties, it is apparent that compliance of Clause I(a) of sub-section 2 of Section 82 of the Code of Criminal Procedure has not been made.

Learned counsel appearing for the State of Haryana also does not dispute that fact. The petitioner who has been declared proclaimed person is ready to join. The case is pending before the trial Court.

Keeping in view the aforesaid fact, the order dated 22.05.2018 declaring the petitioner proclaimed person is set aside.

The petitioner is directed to appear before the trial Court within 15 days and apply for bail. If such an application is filed, the same shall be decided by the Court within two days.

Accordingly, the present petition is disposed of while setting aside the order dated 22.05.2018.
