In the present writ petition, the grievance of the petitioner is that the petitioner was promoted as a Statistical Assistant on 08.10.1996 and ultimately petitioner retired from the said post on 31.07.2018 i.e. after rendering 22 years of service in the same cadre but the respondents have not given the benefit of ACP for which the petitioner is entitled for after 9 years and 14 years of service in the said cadre.

Learned counsel for the petitioner states that for the relief which has been claimed in the present writ petition, the petitioner has served upon the respondents with a representation dated 29.01.2019 (Annexure P-15) and the petitioner will be satisfied, at this stage, in case a time bound direction is issued to the respondents to decide the representation dated 29.01.2019 (Annexure P-15) by passing an appropriate speaking order.

Without commenting upon the merits of the case or about the entitlement of the petitioner for the relief which has been claimed by her in the representation dated 29.01.2019 (Annexure P-15), the present writ petition is disposed of with a direction to the respondents to decide the

representation dated 29.01.2019 (Annexure P-15) within a period of three months from the receipt of certified copy of this order.

In case, it is found that the petitioner is entitled for any monetary benefits after the decision of the representation, the same should also be paid to her within three months thereafter.
