The grievance of the petitioners is that a complaint in writing has been made to the police against the private respondents for having tampered with the agreement to sell dated 20.8.2016 by falsely making an endorsement thereon regarding alleged receipt of a sum of ₹ 5 lacs by petitioner No.1. Thereafter, a detailed representation dated 12.7.2018 (Annexure P-13) has been made which was received in the office of respondent No.2 on same day but no action has been taken thereupon till date.

Notice of motion to respondents No.1 to 4 only.

Mr. Luvinder Sofat, learned AAG, Punjab accepts notice. Let five copies of the complete paper book be supplied to him during the course of day.

Keeping in view the nature of order being passed, no notice is required to be issued to respondents No.5 and 6.

The petition stands disposed of with a direction to respondent No.2 to objectively consider the representation dated 12.7.2018 (Annexure P-13) and to take appropriate action thereupon in accordance with law, in case found necessary,

within a period of eight weeks from the date of receipt of certified copy of this order.
