Present petition has been filed under Section 482 Cr.P.C. praying for quashing of order dated 29.03.2017 (**P-1**), passed by learned Judicial Magistrate 1st Class, Faridabad, whereby, learned trial Court has only summoned respondent No.2-Pardeep Rana and not summoned remaining respondent Nos.3 to 17, who, being public servants, have committed the fraud in the account of Resident Welfare Association, Sector 55, Faridabad in connivance with respondent No.2.

There is no representation on behalf of the petitioner.

On the last date of hearing also, none appeared on behalf of the petitioner.

It transpires that on 31.05.2018 too, this case was dismissed for non-prosecution, but subsequently on an application of the petitioner, the same was restored, vide order dated 24.08.2018.

It seems that the petitioner is not interested in pursuing the present petition.

In view of above, this Court has no option except to dismiss the present petition again for want of prosecution.
