1. Revision petition has been filed under Article 227 of the Constitution of India praying for setting aside order dated 06.03.2019, passed by the learned Civil Judge (Junior Division), Rajpura, whereby possession of the property in dispute has been delivered to the respondent/decreed-holder as also for setting aside order dated 27.02.2019, whereby permission was granted to break open the locks of the property/residential house in dispute.

2. Learned counsel for the petitioners states that Civil Appeal No.885/2017 in case titled Jaswinder Singh vs. Walait Singh is pending adjudication before the learned Addl. District Judge, Patiala and that the petitioners would be satisfied if the revision petition is disposed of by

directing the learned Addl. District Judge, Patiala to consider and decide the aforementioned appeal in a time bound manner.
