The present petition has been filed under Section 439 Code of Criminal Procedure for grant of regular bail to the petitioner in case FIR No.207 dated 29.10.2018, registered under Sections 306, 34 IPC at Police Station Sardulgarh, District Mansa.

Allegations have been levelled against the petitioner that he and his wife instigated the deceased-Amandeep Kaur for making an attempt to suicide who committed suicide by hanging herself.

The allegations levelled against the wife of the petitioner is that she said that deceased has illicit relations with the petitioner. This allegation was made on 27.10.2018. On 29.10.2018, at about 2.45 p.m. i.e. on the day of occurrence, the deceased had gone to one Chamkaur Singh who called her and shut down the gate of his house. Thereafter, Karmjit Kaur and Sarbjit Singh @ Gaggi shouted and they insulted the deceased and deceased committed suicide at about

overt act has been attributed to the petitioner.

I have heard the learned counsel for the parties and have gone through the record.

The petitioner is in custody since 30.12.2018. The trial of the case will take long time. No useful purpose will be served by keeping the petitioner in custody.

Without expressing any opinion on merits of the case and keeping in view the fact that conclusion of trial will take considerably long time, the present petition is allowed. Petitioner-Sarbjit Singh is ordered to be released on regular bail on furnishing bail bond and surety bond to the satisfaction of concerned trial Court/Chief Judicial Magistrate/Duty Magistrate, subject to following terms:-

- (a) The petitioner shall comply with the conditions mentioned in Section 437(3) Cr.P.C.
- (b) In the event of his absence on any date of hearing, the benefit of bail allowed to the petitioner shall stand withdrawn. The trial Court shall be competent to cancel his bail bond and surety bond and proceed to procure his presence in accordance with law. In that eventuality the petitioner shall have to apply for bail afresh.
- (c) He shall not leave the country without the prior permission of the Court.
