Present petition has been filed under Section 438 Cr.P.C. for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioner in case FIR No.156 dated 25.09.2018, under Sections 379 and 411 of the Indian Penal Code, 1860, registered at Police Station Zira, District Ferozepur.

This Court, while issuing notice of motion on 19.03.2019, passed the following order:-

“ Contends that co-accused of the petitioner namely Devinder Singh has already been granted the concession of ad interim pre arrest bail by this Court vide order dated 08.03.2019, passed in CRM-M-10651-2019.

Notice of motion for 08.04.2019.

To be heard along with CRM-M-10651-2019. In the meanwhile, the petitioner is directed to join the investigation before the Investigating Officer. In the event of

his arrest, the Arresting Officer would admit him to interim bail till the next date of hearing on his furnishing adequate bail and surety bonds to his satisfaction. The petitioner is also directed to abide by all the conditions as envisaged under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C. ”

Contentends that in terms of above order, petitioner has joined the investigation and his custodial interrogation is no longer required.

The aforesaid factual position is duly acknowledged by learned State Counsel, on instructions from HC Karaj Singh.

In view of above, interim order dated 19.03.2019 is made absolute subject to the conditions as envisaged under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C. and the present petition stands disposed off.

It is made clear that the petitioner shall fully co-operate with the Investigating Officer as and when called for further investigation.
