The prayer made in this petition filed under Articles 226/227 of the Constitution of India, is for issuance of a writ in the nature of *Certiorari* for setting aside the letter/communication dated 06.12.2018 (**Annexure P-5**), vide which the petitioner has been asked to deposit ₹ 67 lakhs under one time settlement scheme. Further prayer has also been made to direct the respondents to accept the share of the petitioner-Firm as per outstanding amount against it under the OTS Scheme.

2. At the outset, learned counsel for the petitioner submitted that inadvertently certain necessary averments could not be incorporated and relevant documents appended along with the writ petition. Accordingly, a prayer was made that he may be allowed to withdraw the present writ petition with liberty to the petitioner to file fresh one on the same cause of action by furnishing better particulars.

3. Dismissed as withdrawn with liberty as prayed for.
