This revision petition has been filed challenging the order dated 16.01.2019 passed by Additional Sessions Judge, Gurdaspur whereby the petitioners have been summoned.

Notice of motion.

On the asking of the Court, Ms.Amarjit Kaur Khurana, DAG, Punjab accepts notice on behalf of the respondent-State and the copy of the paper book has been supplied to her in the Court itself.

In the case of a similarly situated co-accused who had filed **CRM-M-10513-2019** titled as ***Jagga Masih and another Vs. State of Punjab*** listed at Sr.No.210 decided on today i.e. on 19.03.2019, I grant bail to enable that co-accused to face the trial.

Learned counsel for the petitioners states that in case the same protection is granted to the petitioners they would not press this petition on merits.

Learned DAG states that she has no objection if the petitioners are granted bail to enable them to face the trial.

In the circumstances, it is stated that the challenge to the summoning order is rejected but it is directed that petitioners would appear before the trial Court who shall release them on bail to its satisfaction to enable them to face the trial.

Revision petition stands disposed of.

Since the main case has been decided, the pending criminal miscellaneous application, if any, also stands disposed of.
