Prayer in the present petition filed under Section 438 of the Code of Criminal Procedure, 1973 is for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioner in FIR No.13 dated 02.03.2019 under Sections 406, 498-A, 323 IPC, registered at Police Station Sadar Kurali, District SAS Nagar, Mohali.

Vide order dated 19.03.2019 passed by this Court, while staying the arrest of the petitioner, the parties were directed to appear before the Mediation and Conciliation Centre of this Court.
