Petitioners have approached this Court seeking issuance of directions to respondents No.1 and 2 to get the matter in question inquired from senior police official and that too an officer from outside District Karnal or by constituting a Special Investigating Team.

Learned counsel for the petitioners has submitted that earlier in the year 2014, FIR No.453, dated 8.6.2014, registered at Police Station Civil Lines, Karnal, under Sections 406, 420, 467, 468, 471, 506 and 120-B IPC was lodged at the instance of petitioner No.1 against respondents No.5 to 9 which was later on quashed on the basis of compromise between the parties. Learned counsel submits that now after the matter having been resolved, one of the accused arrayed in the earlier FIR namely Sapna has moved an

application to the police alleging that she had falsely been implicated in the earlier case and was unnecessarily threatened and forced into a compromise and that in fact there was a conspiracy to falsely implicate the accused in the said case and that the same be inquired into.

Learned counsel has submitted that pursuant to filing of the aforesaid complaint (Annexure P-6), the petitioners are being unnecessarily harassed by the police and are being called to the police station time and again by respondent No.4.

Having heard the learned counsel for the petitioners, the petition is disposed of with a direction to Superintendent of Police, Karnal (respondent No.2) to look into the matter and to ensure that the matter is got inquired fairly by an Officer not below the rank of Deputy Superintendent of Police, who shall keep respondent No.2 updated about the entire inquiries/investigation conducted in the matter and shall also inform him before any final decision is taken in the matter.

A copy of this order be sent to respondent No.2-Superintendent of Police, Karnal so as to enable him to do the needful expeditiously.
