After arguing this case for some time, learned counsel for the petitioner seeks to withdraw this revision petition on the premise that no objections in terms of Order 21 Rule 64 CPC have been filed so far. The share of the petitioner i.e. 11 *marlas* of land has not been determined by the executing Court. The total liability of the petitioner would be subject to the valuation of the land on the basis of market value.

Precisely in view of aforesaid premise the petitioner seeks to withdraw this revision petition with a liberty to file appropriate objections before the executing Court.

Dismissed as withdrawn.

In the event of filing such objections, the executing Court shall decide the same in accordance with law.
