The grievance of the petitioner is that the official respondents are harassing and misbehaving with him at the behest of respondent No.5 who is the wife of the petitioner. The petitioner has been repeatedly called by the police to the police station and he was also beaten by them. Counsel for the petitioner further states that there is no case pending against the petitioner. His limited prayer is that in case, presence of the petitioner is required in connection with any complaint filed by respondent No.5, then the petitioner be given a notice as contemplated in Section 160 Cr.P.C.

Accordingly, without commenting on the merits of the case or the veracity of the allegations in the petition, this petition is disposed of with direction that in case, the presence of the petitioner is required in connection with any case filed by respondent No.5, the provisions of Section 160 Cr.P.C be strictly complied with.
