TEJINDER SINGH DHINDSA, J.

The petitioner is pursuing the MBBS Course under the respondent-Baba Farid University of Health Sciences, Faridkot. He appeared in the 2nd Prof. examination in the month of December 2018 and the result of which was declared on 25.1.2019. As per pleadings on record, there were four papers/subjects for the 2nd Prof. and one of them was that of Pharmacology-A and B. In the result that has been declared, petitioner has failed to negotiate the Pharmacology-A and B paper but has passed in the other three papers.

The instant writ petition has been filed seeking a mandamus directing the respondent-University to resort to re-evaluation of his answer sheets of Pharmacology-A and B by way of manual checking.

The prayer is founded on the basis that the University has resorted to evaluation of answer sheets by way of e-evaluation and that examiners had not been properly trained to carry out such evaluation and as such manual evaluation of the answer sheets should have been the order of the day.

Having heard counsel for the petitioner at length, this Court is of the considered view that the prayer made in the petition is not well founded.

Strangely, the prayer in the instant writ petition is confined only to one subject, i.e. Pharmacology-A and B. In so far as, the other three papers are concerned in which the petitioner has qualified/passed, he has chosen to accept evaluation of the answer sheets done by way of e-evaluation. His objection is confined only to one subject, i.e. Pharmacology-A and B. Such piecemeal prayer cannot be accepted.

Petition is dismissed.
