Prayer in the present petition filed under Section 439 Cr.P.C. is for grant of regular bail to the petitioner in case FIR No.46 dated 15.10.2017 registered under Sections 328/376/506 of IPC at Women Police Station, Panchkula, District Panchkula.

Learned State counsel, on instructions from ASI Karanjit Kaur, states that there are total 13 witnesses cited by the prosecution and 8 witnesses have already been examined. The remaining witnesses are formal and likely to be examined in the near future. Moreover, the case is fixed for PWs for tomorrow.

Faced with this situation, learned counsel for the petitioner does not press the present petition.

Dismissed as not pressed.

Considering the advance stage of trial and the petitioner being in custody since 15.10.2017, the trial Court shall expedite the trial.
