ANUPINDER SINGH GREWAL, J. (ORAL)

The petitioner is seeking cancellation of anticipatory bail granted to respondent No.2 in FIR No.39 dated 29.01.2018 under Sections 406/420 IPC, registered at Police Station Phillaur, District Jalandhar Rural.

In the FIR, it is alleged by the complainant that the respondent accused had taken sum of Rs.2,25,000/- from the complainant and fled away from the spot. This amount was received by the complainant after selling her gold ornaments.

A perusal of the order granting anticipatory bail indicates that the parties had entered into a compromise on 02.11.2017 and the son of the petitioner had given Rs.2,25,000/- to the respondent/ accused and he had agreed to pay the remaining amount of Rs.2,75,000/- through four cheques within 11 months. It is, thus, evident that there were business dealings between the two and they had also arrived at a compromise with regard thereto.

Therefore, I do not find any manifest illegality in the order granting bail to respondent No.2. Consequently, the petition stands dismissed.
