The petitioner has preferred the instant petition under Section 438 Cr.P.C., for grant of anticipatory bail in case FIR No.96 dated 20.08.2016, registered under Sections 363, 366-A of the Indian Penal Code at Police Station Sadar Sri Muktsar Sahib.

Learned counsel for the petitioner has submitted that petitioner had solemnized married with the prosecutrix.

Learned State counsel on instructions from SI Pritam Singh, PS Sadar Muktsar Sahib, has submitted that the petitioner has joined the investigation; nothing is to be recovered from him and he is no more required for custodial interrogation.

In the circumstances, without going into the merits of the case, I do not deem it appropriate to deny the concession of anticipatory bail to the petitioner in the present case. Ordered accordingly.

Resultantly, the interim order dated 01.06.2018 is made absolute subject to the conditions as envisaged under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.

Petition stands allowed.
