RAMENDRA JAIN, J. (ORAL)

Learned counsel for respondent No.3-Insurance Company submits that there is no scope of enhancement of compensation in this appeal, inasmuch as, the appellant had claimed compensation under Section 163-A of the Motor Vehicles Act (in short-'the Act') wherein he has been awarded compensation in accordance with structured formula laid down in IInd Schedule of the Act.

Learned counsel for the claimant has not been able to refute above submission of learned counsel for respondent No.3-Insurance Company.

Hence, finding no option, this appeal is liable to be dismissed, being meritless.
