Prayer in the instant petition is for issuance of directions to respondents No.2 and 3 to protect the lives and liberty of the petitioners, at the hands of respondents No.4 to 7.

Status report by way of affidavit of Senior Superintendent of Police, Patiala on behalf of respondent No.2 has been filed today in the Court, which is support by the report of Deputy Superintendent of Police, Samana (Annexure R-1/T). As per the enquiry, it is found that the petitioners have no danger to their lives and liberty at the hands of respondents No.4 to 7.

Counsel appearing for respondents No.4 to 7 has stated that they are not interfering in the personal lives of the petitioners.

In view of the same, this petition stands disposed of as having been rendered infructuous.

However, liberty is granted to the petitioners to file a fresh petition if they still found any threat to their lives and liberty.
