AVNEESH JHINGAN, J (Oral):

The present contempt petition has been filed pleading wilful disobedience of order dated 09.03.2018 passed by this Court in CWP No.5793 of 2018.

The operational part of the order is reproduced below:-

“3. Instant petition is disposed of with a direction to respondent No.1 Chairman-cum-Managing Director, Punjab State Power Corporation Ltd/PSPCL, Patiala to look into the grievances unfolded by the petitioner in legal notice dated 27.02.2017 (Annexure P-5) and to decide the same as per circulars 17/1990 dated 23.04.1990 amended from time to time, within a period of three months from the date of receipt of certified copy of this order. However, relief shall stand restricted to 38 months in view of Full Bench judgment of this

Court in “Saroj Kumari v. State of Punjab and others”, 1998(3) SCT 664.

4. However, if the petitioner still feels aggrieved against the order passed by the concerned authority, he shall be at liberty to have recourse to the other remedies as well as to approach this Court.”

Learned counsel for the respondents has produced copy of order dated 28.05.2019 and stated that order of this Court has been complied, same is taken on record. Copy of order is handed over to learned counsel for the petitioner.

In view of above, no further interference is called for in the contempt petition.

The present contempt petition is disposed of as infructuous.

The petitioner would be at liberty to avail remedies as are available in accordance with law, if aggrieved of order passed by the respondents.
