GURVINDER SINGH GILL, J.(Oral)

By way of filing this petition, the petitioner seeks quashing of FIR No.48 dated 13.8.2016 registered at Police Station Nandgarh, District Bathinda under Sections 307, 452 and 34 of Indian Penal Code, 1860 and Section 25 of Arms Act, 1959 and all consequential proceedings emanating therefrom on the basis of a compromise having been effected between the parties.

Vide order dated 2.7.2018, the parties had been directed to appear before the Illaqa Magistrate/trial Court so as to get their statements recorded qua the factum of compromise.

Report of learned Judicial Magistrate 1st Class, Bathinda has been received, wherein it has been reported that the statements of petitioner/accused Ranjot Singh @ Jota @ Navjot Singh and also of complainant Jagdeep Singh have been recorded to the effect that they have

compromised the matter amongst themselves with the intervention of respectables and they have not objection in case the FIR is quashed.

It has specifically been opined by learned Judicial Magistrate 1st Class, Bathinda that the parties have entered into compromise voluntarily without there being any pressure, coercion or undue influence.

In view of the aforesaid compromise and bearing in mind the law laid down by Full Bench of this Court in 2007(3) RCR (CrL.) 1052 Kulwinder Singh and others Vs. State of Punjab, the present petition is allowed and FIR No.48 dated 13.8.2016 registered at Police Station Nandgarh, District Bathinda under Sections 307, 452 and 34 of Indian Penal Code, 1860 and Sections 25 of Arms Act, 1959 and all the consequent proceedings arising therefrom are hereby quashed qua the petitioner.
