AJAY TEWARI, J. (ORAL)

Petition has been filed under Section 482 Cr.P.C. for quashing of FIR No.9 dated 11.01.2007 registered under Sections 325, 324, 323, 342, 34 IPC and all consequential proceedings arising therefrom on the basis of compromise between the parties.

Statements have been recorded and as per the same the dispute has been settled. Learned Senior Deputy Advocate General however points out that this is a case where the petitioners stood convicted and this compromise has taken place during the proceedings of the appeal.

In the circumstances, I deem it appropriate to reject the prayer for quashing the FIR but to reduce the sentence of the petitioners to that which they have already undergone. Ordered accordingly.

Petition stands disposed of.

Since the main case has been decided, the pending criminal miscellaneous application, if any, also stands disposed of.
