for issuance of appropriate directions to respondents No. 2 to 4 to look
into the grievance of the petitioners on the basis of the representations
Annexures P-4 and P-5.

In response to the notice of motion issued by this Court,
reply by way of affidavit of Harpreet Singh, PPS, Deputy
Superintendent of Police, Sub Division Ajnala, Amritsar Rural has
been filed on behalf of respondents No. 1 to 4/State. The same is

taken on record.

Perusal of the preliminary submissions of the reply reveals that initially FIR No. 136 dated 12.09.2017, under Sections 324 and 34 of the Indian Penal Code at Police Station Ajnala, Amritsar Rural was registered against the accused-Varinder Singh, Kulwinder Singh and Mintu Bhala. After investigation in the matter report under Section 173 Cr.P.c. has already been submitted before the Court of Illaqa Magistrate and consequent upon framing of the charges the case is fixed for prosecution evidence.

In view of the above, no further directions are required to be issued in the matter and the same is disposed off as such.

However, it is clarified that petitioners would be at liberty to raise all their grievance before learned trial Court at appropriate stage(s) in accordance with law.
