MANOJ BAJAJ, J.

The present petition has been filed by the petitioners under Section 482 Cr.P.C. for issuance of a direction to the official respondents No.1 to 3 for protection of their lives and liberty at the hands of private respondents No.4 to 7.

Learned counsel for the petitioners submits that a few days ago respondent No.4, who is husband of petitioner No.1, after giving beatings threw petitioner No.1 out from her matrimonial home in the night. He further submits that when everyone abandoned her, then she called petitioner No.2, who is allegedly her close friend and known to her for the last two years, who took her home and since then both the petitioners are in live-in-relationship. However, it is not disputed by the counsel for the petitioners that petitioner No.1 is married with respondent No.4 and has two sons from their marriage. Petitioner No.1 has not taken divorce till today from her husband (respondent No.4).

In view of the above, no ground is made out for invoking inherent powers under Section 482 Cr.P.C.

Dismissed.
