This petition has been filed under Section 439 Cr.P.C. for grant of regular bail to the petitioner in case F.I.R. No.281 dated 06.08.2016 registered under Sections 420/465/467/468/471/120-B IPC at Police Station Udyog Vihar, Gurugram, Haryana.

Custody certificate dated 30.03.2019 filed by way of affidavit of Kuldeep Kumar, Deputy Superintendent, District Prison (Gurgaon), Haryana on behalf of State is taken on record. Copy supplied to the counsel opposite.

Counsel for the petitioner has argued that in two similar cases the petitioner was granted regular bail by orders dated 14.01.2019 passed in **CRM-M-64522 of 2018** and **CRM-M-64781-2018**.

Learned State counsel on instructions from SI Rajinder Singh has accepted these factual assertions.

Be that as it may and keeping in view the above facts and the period of incarceration already suffered by the petitioner and without going into the merits of the case, I deem it appropriate to release the petitioner on regular bail to the satisfaction of the concerned CJM/Illaqa Magistrate/Duty Magistrate.

Ordered accordingly.

Petition stands allowed.

Since the main case has been decided, the pending criminal miscellaneous application, if any, also stands disposed of.
