MAHABIR SINGH SINDHU, J.(Oral)

Present petition has been filed under Section 438 of the Code of Criminal Procedure for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioners in criminal complaint No. 7/18 dated 17.01.2018 (P-17), under Sections 148, 149, 307, 323, 325, 363, 364, 367, 452, 506 and 120-B of the Indian Penal Code.

On 20.03.2019, while issuing notice of motion, the following order was passed by this Court:

“Contentends that regarding the same very occurrence dated 15.09.2017, FIR No. 768 dated 15.09.2017 under Sections 307/323/450 and 506 IPC and Section 25 of the Arms Act, 1959 was registered against the complainant – respondent no.2 by Deepika Bhatia (petitioner no.1) and after a period of four months i.e on 17.01.2018, a criminal complaint (P-17) was filed as a counter blast by the complainant–respondent no.2 Hitesh Rana, in which the petitioners have been summoned by learned Judicial Magistrate Ist Class, Karnal vide order dated 07.12.2018 (P-18) for commission of offence punishable under

Sections 148, 149, 307, 323, 325, 364, 366, 367, 506 and 120-B IPC and apprehending their arrest.

Notice of motion for 02.05.2019.

In the meanwhile, the petitioners are directed to appear before the learned trial Court and in case they move an application for bail, they would be released on interim bail till the next date of hearing on their furnishing adequate bail and surety bonds to its satisfaction. The petitioners are also directed to abide by all the conditions as envisaged under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.”

Learned Senior counsel for the petitioners has produced the photocopy of the order dated 26.03.2019 passed by learned Judicial Magistrate First Class, Karnal to the effect that in terms of the order dated 20.03.2019, the petitioners have joined proceedings before learned trial Court.

In view of the above, the order dated 20.03.2019 is made absolute subject to the provisions of Section 438(2) Cr. P.C.

Petition stands disposed off.

However, it is clarified that the petitioners shall fully co-operate with proceedings before learned trial Court.
