GURVINDER SINGH GILL, J. (Oral)

1. The petitioners seek quashing of FIR No.194 dated 24.09.2009 under Sections 406, 420 of the Indian Penal Code, Police Station Phase-8, Mohali and proceedings emanating therefrom on the basis of a compromise having been effected between the parties.
2. Notice of motion had been issued on 11.7.2017. Thereafter vide order dated 25.1.2018 the parties were directed to appear before the Illaqa Magistrate/trial Court for getting their statements recorded qua factum of compromise. However the statements were not got recorded and the matter was adjourned several times and ultimately the matter was dismissed for non-prosecution on 22.5.2018.

3. Pursuant to an application moved for recalling of order dated 22.5.2018 the petition was restored. However I find that there has been no representation on behalf of the petitioner on the last two dates i.e. on 6.12.2018 and 8.2.2019. Even today none has appeared on behalf of the petitioner. In these circumstances, it is quite apparent that the petitioner is not interested in pursuing this matter.
4. Dismissed for non-prosecution.
