ARVIND SINGH SANGWAN, J.

Prayer in this petition is for grant of regular bail to the petitioner in FIR No.396 dated 03.11.2016 under Sections 394, 379-B IPC, Sections 25/54/59 of Arms Act and Section 397 IPC (added later on), registered at Police Station KUK, District Kurukshetra.

As per allegations in the FIR, which was registered on the complaint of Head Treasurar of PNB, Mirzapur, on 03.11.2016, the complainant, along with other officials, was present in the Bank, when four persons entered the Bank and caused injuries to the employees and by aiming pistols on head of the complainant, had taken away an amount of Rs.4,07,0768/-.

The earlier two applications filed by the petitioner were

dismissed on 13.09.2017 and 12.01.2018.

Learned State counsel, on instructions from ASI Gulzar Singh, has submitted that more than 20 prosecution witnesses have already been examined and they have supported the prosecution version and the trial is at the advanced stage.

After hearing learned counsel for the parties, I find that there is no change in the circumstances, especially in view of the fact that prosecution witnesses have duly supported the prosecution version. Mere fact that the petitioner is in long custody, is not a ground to grant him regular bail.

Considering the serious allegations levelled against the petitioner, I find no ground to grant regular bail to him.

Dismissed.
