State has submitted the report. It comes out that the petitioner is the only son. Petitioner has three sisters who are married. State has also verified that mother of the petitioner, aged about 70 years, is suffering from bulky uterus. As per medical report she was advised surgery on 11.3.2019.

Since, the petitioner is the only son and mother of the petitioner needs surgery, therefore, even though the petitioner has not completed sentence of one year, emergency parole is granted to the petitioner. He is ordered to be released on parole for three weeks to the satisfaction of District Magistrate concerned and subject to such conditions as may be imposed, for the purpose of operation and post operative care of his mother.

Petition is accordingly allowed.
