Prayer in the petition is to grant regular bail in FIR No.103 dated 16.09.2018 under Sections 18, 29 of the Narcotic Drugs and Psychotropic Substances Act, 1985, Police Station Sujanpur, District Pathankot.

The alleged recovery from the petitioner and others is a non-commercial quantity. As per the custody certificate, the petitioner has already undergone sentence of 07 months and 13 days.

Learned counsel appearing for the State of Punjab has submitted that the investigation is complete and the challan has been presented. He further submitted that she is not involved in any other case.

Without commenting on the merits of the case and keeping in view the fact that the trial of the case is likely to take a long time, the petitioner is directed to be released on regular bail subject to furnishing of

adequate surety to the satisfaction of the Chief Judicial Magistrate/Duty Magistrate, Pathankot.

Accordingly, the present petition is allowed.
