The petitioner has sought regular bail in case FIR No.106 dated 06.12.2018 under Sections 326, 323, 34 IPC registered at Police Station Bahav Wala, District Fazilka.

The allegations in the FIR lodged on the statement of one Gagandeep is that there was a dispute regarding playing crackers. On the day of the incident dated 07.11.2018, he was going to his house on foot. When he reached near the flour mill (chakki) of Balbir Singh then Ramesh Kumar armed with toki, Pritam armed with iron rod and Jagdish (petitioner) empty handed, who were standing there raised a lalkara for teaching a lesson to the complainant. Ramesh Kumar with his toki gave two blows to the complainant due to which his eye got damaged. Pritam and Jagdish-petitioner gave fist blows to Gagandeep (cousin of the complainant).

Learned counsel for the petitioner states that the petitioner is only alleged to have given fist blow to cousin of the complainant.

The petitioner is in custody since 17.01.2019. The trial may take a long time to conclude. No useful purpose would be served by the continued detention of the petitioner.

Accordingly, this petition is allowed.

The petitioner is ordered to be released on bail on his furnishing bail bonds/surety bonds to the satisfaction of the concerned Trial Court//Duty Magistrate.
