Petitioner has prayed for a writ in the nature of mandamus to direct the respondents to consider her request for extension in service as per existing policy. A detailed reply has been filed on behalf of State. Learned State counsel submits that petitioner was working as 'Trained Dai', which has been declared a diminishing cadre vide letter dated 19.12.2014 Annexure R/1. As such, there is no provision for granting extension in service to a diminishing cadre employee. According to State counsel, there is clear instructions in this regard. Case of the petitioner was duly considered in light of same and rejected vide letter dated 2.4.2019. I find substance in the plea of the State. No case for interference in the writ jurisdiction is made out.

Dismissed.
