This petition under Section 482 of the Code of Criminal Procedure has been filed for quashing of FIR No.0045 dated 16.06.2017 registered under Sections 323, 324, 506, 34 of IPC (section 326 of IPC added later on), at Police Station Kahnuwan, District Gurdaspur and all subsequent proceedings arising therefrom, on the basis of compromise arrived at between the parties.

Accordingly, the parties were directed to appear before the Illaqa Magistrate/Trial Court for getting their statements recorded; qua the genuineness of the compromise.

The Judicial Magistrate 1st Class, Gurdaspur, vide letter dated 20.08.2018, had reported that none of the parties appeared before him for getting the statements recorded. The case was again adjourned for 26.11.2018. However, still parties have not got their statements recorded to support the compromise as claimed in the petition.

In view of the above, it is clear that the compromise, claimed by the petitioners and as mentioned in the petition, has not matured between the parties. Therefore, the present petition deserves to be dismissed.

Dismissed, at this stage.
