The petitioner has approached this Court seeking issuance of a direction to respondent No.3 not to pressurize the petitioner to effect a compromise with respondent No.4 in respect of a civil suit pending amongst the parties.

Learned counsel for the petitioner has submitted that the petitioner had instituted a civil suit No. 2101/2018 titled as Baljit Singh Vs. Sonika Sharma and others, which is pending in the Courts at Ludhiana. It has been submitted that the petitioner is, however, being pressurized by respondent No.3 to effect a compromise and had been called by him to his office and had been humiliated and was also threatened with dire consequences in case the petitioner does not withdraw the civil suit.

Having heard the learned counsel for the petitioner, the petition is disposed of with a direction to the Commissioner of Police, Ludhiana (respondent No.2) to look into the matter and to dispose of the representation dated 20.1.2019 (Annexure P-2) expeditiously and also to ensure that the petitioner is not pressurized, in any manner from any quarters to effect a compromise in the civil suit instituted by him.

A copy of this order along with copy of representation Annexure P-2 be sent to the Commissioner of Police, Ludhiana (respondent No.2) so as to enable him to do the needful expeditiously.
