During the course of hearing, learned counsel for the petitioners has informed the Court that the AC 1st Grade has taken the symbolic possession of the land in dispute in the month of January 2019.

The whole case of the petitioners is that in terms of Section 8 of the Punjab Village Common Lands (Regulation) Act, 1961 [for short 'the Act'], the possession of the standing crop could not be taken until and unless it is harvested. If that is so, the remedy lies with the petitioners to move an application in terms of Section 8 of the Act before the AC 1st Grade for seeking protection of their crop till it is harvested.

With these observations, the present petition is hereby disposed of.
