The petitioner has approached this Court under Article 226 of the Constitution of India, inter alia, for issuance of a writ in the nature of mandamus directing the respondent-bank to allow the petitioner to abide by the terms of OTS of third party and to recognize tripartite agreement proposed to be entered between the Bank, the petitioner and respondent No.3.

2. At the outset, learned counsel for the petitioner submitted that inadvertently relevant averments could not be incorporated and essential documents appended with the writ petition. Accordingly, prayer was made that he may be allowed to withdraw the present petition with liberty to the petitioner to file fresh one on the same cause of action with better particulars.

3. Dismissed as withdrawn with liberty as prayed for.
